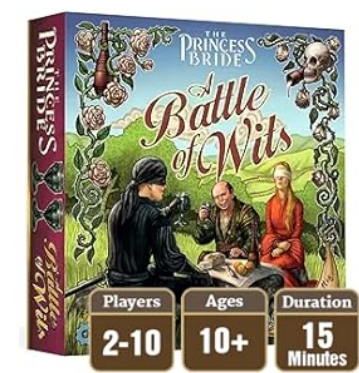




Who Will Survive?

A Battle of Wits is an exciting game of bluff and double bluff for between two and ten players. A row of goblets sits in the middle of the table, ready to be filled with either wine or poison. Players each take the role of one character but it is only at the very end of a game that they will drink, one from each goblet. During the game, they must play their cards, one each turn, either into the top of a goblet (adding poison or wine to a goblet) or to the bottom of a goblet (bidding on the goblet). Who will fall prey to their enemies and who will eliminate themselves? Only the most intelligent will survive!

The Game Includes: 96 Wine/Poison Cards, 10 Goblet Cards, 12 Character Cards, 1 Times Card



Pour your wine.. or your poison

Pick a goblet on the table and deal a card from your hand to secretly pour wine or poison.

Make your bid for the goblet you believe is the least likely to kill you



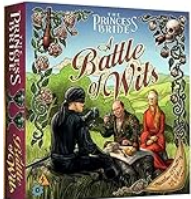
Discover your fate

Add up the contents of the goblets and discover who survives this Sicilian gambit.



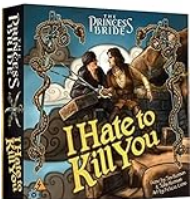

A SWORD DUEL

I Hate to Kill You is a quick and crafty dice and card game that recreates and re-imagines the sword duels from The Princess Bride in just 7 minutes. Play as the Man In Black, Inigo Montoya, Count Rugen or Prince Humperdinck. On a turn, both players roll their dice and then play a card which may modify the outcome. As the tension builds, and players lose more dice and more cards, bluffing (and of course, switching hands) may win you the round. The first player to score 5 hits wins the day!

The game includes: 12 Sword Dice, 5 Health Cards, 50 Moves Cards, 5 Reference Cards

Roll your dice to see how many and how strong your hits are, then make moves in turn.



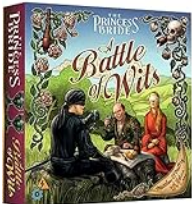

Hit points are tallied by rotating your health card. Flip your card for one last desperate stand.



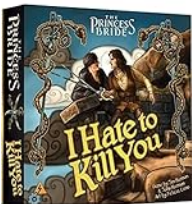

The Game Includes: 261 "Hello My Name Is Cards", 243 "Prepare to Die" Cards, 36 Blank Cards



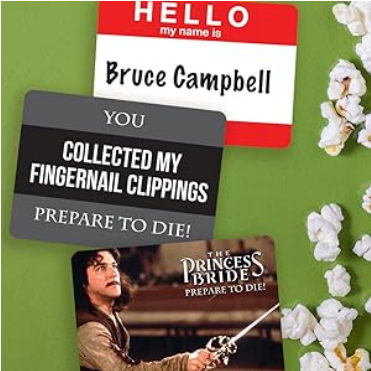
Hello, My Name Is...

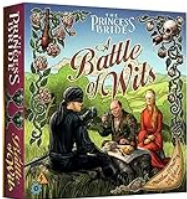
You Killed My Father.

Other players play a black card face down that they hope will inflame the Current Player's righteous indignation and thirst for revenge. Successfully antagonize the Current players 3 times to win!



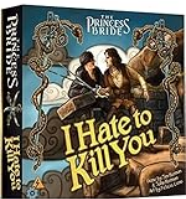
